

Suicide Prevention in North Queensland

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Workshop description

This workshop will be of particular interest to GPs, mental health professionals, and allied health professionals—however should be considered by all who care about the wellbeing of their community and want to know how they can play their part.

Suicide prevention encompasses a range of interventions including health promotion, early intervention, and crisis support. It also includes ongoing intervention for people experiencing suicidal thoughts and behaviour, and responding to and supporting families and communities impacted by suicide.

Participants will learn what is happening in North Queensland with regards to suicide prevention.

- suicide prevention community action plans guided by the Lifespan model from Black Dog Institute
- overview on the national suicide prevention trial project in Townsville with the veteran community
- how collaboration can take 'good' to 'great'
- the importance of listening to the voice of those with a 'lived experience'
